# Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Oregon Gulch Reservoir #2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Oregon Gulch and intermittent tributary of Jenny Creek,

a tributary of the Klamath River

3. The amount of water to be stored is less than 1/4 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is for stock watering purposes  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 29  
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 40 S., R. 4 E., W.M., in the county of Jackson

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet  
Located just to one side of a small intermittent drainage. Heavy, sticky soil at the outlet.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions  
Filled by partial spring runoff and from a seep at the site.

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 S. 29, Sec. 29  
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 40 S., R. 4 E., W.M. The maximum height will be 4.5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 87 feet; length on bottom 77 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 1:1; slope on back 1:1; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.  
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

\* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Dam was built by a tractor with angle dozer from soil at the site or immediately adjacent. Due to its small size, no protection from wave action is required.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Spillway on west side around end of the dam. It is ten feet wide and two feet deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: See above #8

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1/10 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 2.5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 113.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Dam was constructed in 1958 under the authority of the Taylor Grazing Act of 1934.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Oregon Gulch Reservoir No. 2 and storage of water from Oregon Gulch for stock and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.2 acre feet.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 20, 1964 and

shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965
