Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of **Oregon**, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is **Robert A. Weaver Reservoir**

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is **a branch of McFee Creek** *Up named stream and tributary*
tributary of **Tualatin River**

3. The amount of water to be stored is **five 4/2** acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is **irrigation**
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. **23**
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)
Tp. **2 South R. 3 West**, W.M., in the county of **Yamhill**

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

6. The dam will be located in **the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4**, Sec. **23**,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. **2 South R. 3 West**, W.M. The maximum height will be **10** feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be **150** feet; length on bottom **100** feet; width on top **20** feet; slope on front or water side **30'**; slope on back **20'**; height of dam above water line when full **2 1/2** feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: *Earth filled and packed with heavy equipment.*

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows:

15" Concrete Culvert at head of channel for 50 ft and 2 ft of 15" rigid pipe upstream with a valve for drainage.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be *3/4* acres, with a maximum depth of water of *7.5* feet; and approximate mean depth of water *6* feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ *500.00*

12. Construction work will begin on or before *August 1, 1963*

13. Construction work will be completed on or before *October 1, 1963*
