## Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Timber Canyon Waterhole 060-243

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is  
an unnamed

tributary of Timber Canyon Creek, a tributary of Snake River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0.06 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is stock water  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 13

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: none

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.06 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 3 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 1 foot.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Timber Canyon Waterhole and storage of water from an unnamed tributary of Timber Canyon Creek, a tributary of Snake River for stock water. The right of storage of water as granted herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.06 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is May 9, 1963

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 9, 1964 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.
