Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Little Full Cree. Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Full Creek
tributary of Maine

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.12 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is stock water only
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 2
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)
Tp. 18S., R. 26S., W.M., in the county of Grant

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet
Not a running stream. Rock and silt fillway.

From spring on roof.

6. The dam will be located in 121E, Sec. 5,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 22S., R. 31E., W.M. The maximum height will be 12 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on bottom 100 feet; width on top 5 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 3:1; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: A keyway will be dug and filled with the best impervious material taken from a pit in front of the reservoir. The dam will be 12 ft. high and not to exceed 4 inches and compacted with a cat and camroll. The dam will be riprapped if necessary.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Down stream

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: None (see plans)
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1.2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 15 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 5 feet.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Little Bull Creek Reservoir and storage of water from Bull Creek for livestock and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the state Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 5.16 acre feet.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 16, 1964 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.
