Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation
Oregon non-profit corporation, incorporated 6-7-54

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Juba Reservoir
2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Ac Nary Creek
tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0.25 acre feet
4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Pine Protection
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)
5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 23
(Give sections or township)
Tp. 7S, R. 4W, W.M., in the county of Polk

- (a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet
In channel - sandy clay in stream bed
- (b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Sec. 23
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 7S, R. 4W, W.M. The maximum height will be 7 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 45 feet; length on bottom 25 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope on front or water side 2 - 1; slope on back 3:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: earth fill

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: around dam 8' to 2.3'

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 8" concrete pipe buried in concrete
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.125 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 900.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before on or before one year from date of permit

13. Construction work will be completed on or before two years from date of permit.
