APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE UNAPPROPRIATED WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Eagle Cap Reservoir

New Wallowa Lake Res.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Wallowa River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 100,000 acre feet. to be diverted under secondary Application No. 4401, Permit No. 2696 and supplemental supply

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation, Power & Domestic for lands already having a partial water right (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. s. 4 - 5 and 8 - 9 - 16 - 17 - 20 and 21 Township 3 S R 45 E.W.M.
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Wallowa Lake

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 5

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: **Concrete dam, and banks at either end ripraped and puddled in concrete**
