State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.63 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is stock water only (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 28 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 28 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 31S, R. 43E, W.M. The maximum height will be * feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be feet; length on bottom feet; width on top feet; slope on front or water side (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full feet.

* The pit is 160 wide and 160 feet long, 6 feet deep 3:1 slopes on sides.
