**Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to
Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated
Waters of the State of Oregon**

In the State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation. None.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Winnemucca.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Yerington Creek.

tributary of Canyon Creek.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 3,000,000 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 2.

6. The dam will be located in Winnemucca, Sec. 2,
(smallest legal subdivision)

On Sec. R. 5 W. M. The maximum height will be 100 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 110 feet; length on bottom 35 feet; width on top 15 feet; slope on front

or water side 3:1 (feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 3:1 (feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 7 feet.

*A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from
waves are as follows: 215' TALL WITH EARTH BACK

DOCK TO BE PLACED ON FACE OF DAM FOR DREDGING AND MAINTENANCE PROTECTION

8. The location of wastewater with dimensions are as follows: 2400' x 2' THE DITCH
(State whether over or around the dam)

2' WIDE 2' DEEP 25' LONG 23' LENGTH

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 15' TALL RIGID PIPE
(Note: If you have stream channels running through your application, the location of each channel must be provided with an outlet having an outlet capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir when full will be 12 acres.
With a maximum depth of water of 2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 1
4' 4" 2" feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 75,000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Sept 1st RECEIPT OF PERMIT

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Sept 1st, 1965.
