State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of South Butte Waterhole and storage of water from an unnamed stream for livestock, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.0 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is August 1, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 7, 1965
