Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is **Claudie Reservoir**

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is **Cladie Creek**

tributary of **Columbia River**

3. The amount of water to be stored is **100 acre feet**.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is **Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.**

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in **Sec. 12, Twp. 17 S., R. 13 E., W.M.** (Give sections or townships to be submerged).

6. The dam will be located in **Sec. 12, Twp. 17 S., R. 13 E., W.M.** (Smallest legal subdivision)

(horizontal to vertical) **100** feet; height of dam above water line

when full **100** feet.

Without payment of application fees, forms may be used for the application of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured

without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: A keyway will be dug and filled with concrete, and the maximum height of the dam will be limited if necessary.

8. The location of wastewater with dimensions are as follows: Small structures around the dam (state whether over or around the dam).

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: N.C.E. See diagram. (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, or such capacity and location as per the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be acres, with a maximum depth of water of feet; and approximate mean depth of water feet.

No right or privilege granted by this permit is granted herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Claude Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream for livestock; and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.1 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is August 8, 1961.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 1, 1965 and

shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1965.
