State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is **WESKA RESERVOIR**

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is un-named

3. The amount of water to be stored is **0** acre feet.

or water side **1:1**; slope on back **1:1**; height of dam above water line when full **10** feet horizontal to a vertical

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: A roadway will be dug and filled with material taken from the excavation.

Material taken from the excavation will be used to build the dam in layers, not to exceed 12 inches thick.

The dam will be 20 feet wide at the base and 10 feet wide at the top.
