do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Feathered Friend Pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unnamed intermittent stream  
tributary of Grassland Creek

Dear Mr. Wheeler:

This is in answer to the permit application submitted to me in your letter of Dec. 2, 1963.

1. Wildlife: We will work primarily with the Department starting with fish, when the pond is completed, for protection for other wildlife (birds, snails, etc.) will be made late thereafter. No hunting.

2. Recreational use: The pond will be used for fishing, two or three rowboats, a few picnic tables, and other recreational contents.

3. Fire protection: That we will have a fire hydrant, with a fire truck from fire hydrants, the pond will be a source of water for fire trucks to put their reaction wheels into the water.
