Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is **Feathered Friend Pond**

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is **Irrigation, recreation, and propagation**

6. The dam will be located in **SW 1/4 of Sec 26**

The length on top will be **feet**; length on bottom **feet**; width on top **feet**; slope on front or water side **feet horizontal to 1 vertical**; slope on back **feet horizontal to 1 vertical**; height of dam above water line when full **feet**.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows:

The pond is to be excavated in the earth bank about 1 acre in size and 10 feet deep.

8. The location of wastewater with dimensions are as follows: situated so that when the normal pool level is reached no additional water will flow into the pond.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Sec 4.2
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit of such capacity and the character of the outlet must be such that it will not interfere with the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1 acre with a maximum depth of water of 5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 1 foot.

Dear Mr. Wheeler:

This is in answer to the request for permit application in my letter of Dec. 6, 1962.

1. Wildlife: we plan to have a 10 acre pond with a dam about starting with fish, when the pond is complete, we plan to have protection for other wildlife birds, water, and wild life to come hereafter. No hunting.

2. Recreational use: I am a private, I plan the pond to be about two or three rows wide, a few picnic tables, a small swimming area, sunbaths.
