Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation September 22, 1927 in the State of Georgia

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is to be known as "Plywood Products Reservoir".

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is No name (a branch of Soap Creek) tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 39 M.H.U. acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Mill Industrial water
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 8 & 17
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)
Tp. 10S. R. 4W., W.M., in the county of Benton

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet
Partially in existing channel of intermittent stream and partly in proposed excavation. Sod and clay at outlet.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions In channel

6. The dam will be located in SE¹ SE¹, Sec. 8
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 10S. R. 4W., W.M. The maximum height will be 145 M.H.U. feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 60 feet; length on bottom 20 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 6 feet.
