This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Ione Tree Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream for livestock and wildlife and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.13 acre feet.
