

## Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of *Oregon* do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

Tp. **22S**, R. *12E*, W.M. The maximum height will be *10* feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be *10* feet; length on bottom *10* feet; width on top *10* feet; slope on front or water side *1* vertical to *1* horizontal; slope on back *1* vertical to *1* horizontal; height of dam above water line when full *10* feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows:

The dam is to be built of concrete with a masonry core and rubble masonry on the outside. The dam is to be built on a foundation of sandstone.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows:

The wasteway is to be located on the right side of the dam and is to be 10 feet wide and 10 feet high.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows:

(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet capable of passing the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

To this to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Oke reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream for livestock and wildlife and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the State Engineer to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.21 acre feet

shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1966
