

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is UNNAMED

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1.4 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is fish culture (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, at an full, will be 0.2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 10 feet and a minimum depth of water 7 feet.

- 12. Construction work will begin on or before Oct. 1, 64
- 13. Construction work will be completed on or before Oct. 1, 65
