Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

Josephine County - A Body Politic

do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Wolf Creek Recreation Pool

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Wolf Creek

tributary of Rogue River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is swimming hole recreation

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 22 - NW-1/4 of NW-1/4

Tp. 33 S, R. 6 W, W.M. in the county of Josephine

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet yes.

6. The dam will be located in NW-1/4 of the NW-1/4 Sec. 22

Tp. 33 S, R. 6 W, W.M. The maximum height will be 6 1/2 feet above stream bed on ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 50 feet

bottom 40 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front

or greater side 3 to 1; slope on back 3 to 1; height of dam above water line

of dam will be 2 feet.

* This permit does not constitute a right to divert water from its natural course for any purpose other than that specified in the permit. It is subject to the provisions of the State Water Control Act, Chapter 370, Oregon Statutes.

7. The construction of dam, the material of construction and dimensions are as follows: native rock and clay - rock top

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: around dam 2-1/2' x 4'

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 8" steel pipe thru base of dam

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be .45 acre with a maximum depth of water of 4 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before June 1, 1965

13. Construction work will be completed on or before July 1, 1965

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of three Wolf Creek recreation ponds and storage of water from Wolf Creek for recreation, provided further that an 8 inch outlet suitable to pass the normal flow of the stream be constructed through the base of the dam.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.75 acre feet

The priority date of this permit is January 11, 1965

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 18, 1966 and

shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1967
