4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 10, T. 10N, R. 10E, W.M. in the county of Washington

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth fill across the stream channel.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: 100 ft wide, 10 ft high. (State whether over or around foundation)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit of such capacity and location to carry the normal flow of the stream at all times.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 100 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 10 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$10,000.

12. Construction work will begin on or before August 1, 1911.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before August 1, 1912.

Remarks: Through error the center line of the dam structure under Permit No. R-3200 was moved 100 feet downstream. This caused an increase in storage capacity in the finished reservoir. This application is for the difference in storage between 37.5 acre feet authorized under Permit No. R-3200 and the present capacity of 49.1 acre feet. The water will be used for recreation purposes within the impoundment area.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the ~~enlargement~~ ~~xx~~ enlargement of Lake Camp Baldwin Reservoir constructed under permit No. R-3200 and storage of water from Eight Mile Creek for recreation.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 11.6 acre feet.
