The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is April 16, 1965.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1966 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1967.
