

### Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Wright Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Allen Creek  
tributary of Rogue River

3. The amount of water to be stored is Four acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 31  
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)  
Tp. 36 S., R. 5 W., W.M., in the county of Josephine

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet  
Yes Weathered grano-diorite

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 31  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
Tp. 36 S., R. 5 W., W.M. The maximum height will be 6 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 64' feet; length on bottom 48' feet; width on top 8' feet; slope on front or water side None; slope on back None; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Reinforced Concrete - Flashboard  
2 x 6 Tongue + Groove Fir Timbers

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)  
Through dam and over dam Six,  
6' wide x 2' deep

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Through dam with flashboards  
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)  
removed Six, 6' x 6'

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1 acres,  
with a maximum depth of water of 4 feet; and approximate mean depth of water  
3.8 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 3000

12. Construction work will begin on or before Nov. 1, 1965

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Dec 31, 1965
