

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Edwin R. Warner (Name of Applicant)

of 170 N. 57th Street Springfield (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Lake "La-Lai"

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unamed stream and unamed slough Hr 3-8-67 tributary of McKenzie River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 8.8 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Recreation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 26 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 17S, R. R. 1 W., W.M., in the county of Lane

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet A running stream only at flood stage of McKenzie River. Outlet will be clay and rock fill.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions It is to be filled from an unamed stream coming down the hill from the south and also from a 10 H.P. pump and pipe line to be located 800 ft. north at an unamed slough of clear water.

6. The dam will be located in Lot 5 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 26, Tp. 17S, R. 1W, W.M. The maximum height will be 8.5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 150 feet; length on bottom 20 feet; width on top 15 feet; slope on front or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon 97310.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: The material to be used will be clay & rock; the method of protection will be either concrete asphalt or cement.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)
The waterway will be around the dam thru an 18" mininum width ditch extending north to flow back into the unamed slough. An additional spillway 6 ft. wide will provide watershed for maximum run-off.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: A 12" asphalt dipped corrugated iron pipe with gate
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)
will be provided for reservoir drainage at the lowest lake depth.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be XX 3.3 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2.73 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$10,000

12. Construction work will begin on or before July 1966

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1967
