Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Kirkpatrick's Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Three unnamed springs

tributary of Crabtree Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1.26 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is 0.545 0.721
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)
Irrigation and Fish culture

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. SE 1/4 of NW 1/4
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 10 S, R. 2 W, W.M., in the county of Linn

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

6. The dam will be located in SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec. 26,
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 10 S, R. 2 W, W.M. The maximum height will be 9 1/2 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 200 feet; length on

bottom 150 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front

or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

when full 3 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Packed earth that is removed from the reservoir area

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Wasteway will be at N.E. corner of dam. Will be constructed of concrete and will be 3 feet wide and 3 feet deep as runoff into pond will be very minor.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 4 inch steel pipe with protective collars. Will be located at lowest point under dam which is at the NW corner.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.18 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 8 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 7 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 800.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before August 25, 1967

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1968
