Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is unnamed.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is unnamed drainage tributary to military slough.

tributary to Rogue River - 0.25 cfs (Drain #1 appropriation)

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is wildlife pond
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 18
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

when full 3 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows:

This is an earth fill dam with sodded banks for wave protection.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: The wasteway extends (State whether over or around the dam)

around the east side of the dam, with following dimensions: bottom width - 4 feet; top width- 6 feet; top of dam to bottom of spillway - 3 feet.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: No outlet has been installed. Reservoir will be pumped in order to work on the dam structure.

(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 feet.
