That certain tract of land lying in Section 9, Township 41 South, Range 13 West of the Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe driven on the Southwesterly boundary of the Oregon Coast Highway at a point due North 2027.2 feet from an iron pipe marking the Southeast corner of the James W. Taggart Donation Land Claim No. 40;
