State of California, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Peggy's pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Long Gulch

3. The amount of water to be stored is 4.5 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is 1.5 A.F. Irrigation; 1.5 A.F. fire and fish culture for my own use.

The length on top will be 75 feet; length on bottom 65 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2 1/2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: earth fill. Pond is too small to need wave protection.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam) 3 1/2' wasteway is in original formation, not in dam, 2' wide & 2' deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: not in stream bed (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 3/4 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 8 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 6 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1000

12. Construction work will begin on or before November, 1966

13. Construction work will be completed on or before November, 1969
