Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

bottom feet; width on top 15 feet; slope on front

or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.75 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 7 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1000.00
