Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

6. The dam will be located in W 1/2, Sec. 25 13,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 23S, R. 29E, W.M. The maximum height will be ~~49.53~~ feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be ~~300~~ 1087 feet; length on bottom about 200 feet; width on top 20 18 feet; slope on front or water side 302 3; slope on back 20 2; height of dam above water line when full 5 feet.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before July 1968
