Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, B Boland Crozier (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Oak Shire Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

unnamed intermittent stream

tributary of Berry Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.2 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Stock water & IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 35 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 9S, R. 5W, W.M., in the county of Polk

in channel of intermittent stream

6. The dam will be located in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 35 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 9S, R. 5W, W.M. The maximum height will be 10 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 23.5 feet; length on

bottom 10 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front

or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line

when full 2.2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1800.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Oct. 13, 1967

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Oct. 31, 1967
