Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Beverage Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Slaughter Pond

3. The amount of water to be stored is 6 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation and to keep spring to be used for domestic purpose alone to be appropriated under application No. 8095, permit No. 5217

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 17 T. 3 S. R. 38 E. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Pond is so small there will be no necessity of making extra protection against waves

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: 2 X 2 timber headgate at NE cor. of pond. (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: thro dam thro wood headgate (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 2 1/4 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3 feet.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Nov. 1921
