

## Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Island Inn Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is unnamed stream

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1.1 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 21

6. The dam will be located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 21  
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 11 S, R. 1 E, W.M. The maximum height will be 9 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 50 feet; length on bottom 30 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope on front or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Packed earth construction. Dam will be seeded to grass.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Wasteway around North end of

dam. Wasteway will be constructed of concrete and will be six foot wide and  
four feet deep. Wooden flash boards will keep water level 2.5 feet below top of dam.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Under center of dam and will be a four inch steel pipe with two  
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the  
cut off collars and valve at upper end  
normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.25 acres,  
with a maximum depth of water of 6 feet; and approximate mean depth of water  
4.5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 600.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before April 1, 1969

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1970
