

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Carl E. Suttner (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Suttner Res

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is unnamed stream

3. The amount of water to be stored is 6.0 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Fish Culture (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

bottom 100 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front

or water side 3:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line

when full 2.5 feet.
