

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Beltview Res

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is unnamed stream

tributary of N. Yam hill R.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 15.0 ^{17.4} 75.0 ^{17.4} 25.0 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Fish Culture
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 25
