Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jesse Haines (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Haines Reservoir No. 1

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is the Gibson Gulch tributary of Glenn Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.3 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation) power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 12 Tp. 7S, R. 4W, W.M., in the county of Polk (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

Compacted Clay

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Drainage basin Gibson Gulch

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 12, Tp. 7S, R. 4W, W.M. The maximum height will be 9.8 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 90 feet; length on bottom 40 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.7 feet.
