

**Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon**

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Curtis Loewen  
Reservoir No. 1

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is  
Unnamed field drainage  
tributary of Rickreall Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 20 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Stock  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 26  
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)  
Tp. 7S, R. 4W, W.M., in the county of Polk

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 26,  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
Tp. 7S, R. 4W, W.M. The maximum height will be 5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 300 feet; length on bottom 50 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1400.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before 9/1/20

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 9/1/21
