Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Victor Thumberg (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Thumberg

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

3. The amount of water to be stored is 4 (See remarks) acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Fish & Duck pond
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 25

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of 4, Sec. 25
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 3S, R. 5W, W.M. The maximum height will be 4 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 500 feet; length on

bottom 500 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line

when full 2 1/2 feet.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Dam to be earth construction, packed down in layers with heavy tractor.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Spillway to be around ends of dam where there is adequate space for 10' plus bottom & 30' plus on top.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: This dam is not in a stream bed 4" steel pipe to be placed at lowest point in dam in concrete.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 3 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 2 1/2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 300⁰⁰

12. Construction work will begin on or before Oct 15, 1970

13. Construction work will be completed on or before March 15 1971
