

**Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to
Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated
Waters of the State of Oregon**

State of Oregon 97355, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the
following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to
existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Johnson's Lake

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is
unnamed stream

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0.72 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Livestock water
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 34

6. The dam will be located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 34,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 11S, R. 1W, W.M. The maximum height will be 91 feet above stream bed or ground
surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 150 feet; length on
bottom 50 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front
or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)
when full 24 feet.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Packed soil - no wave problem

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: West end of dam.
(State whether over or around the dam)
Concrete construction 2 feet wide and 3 feet deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 8 inch steel pipe under center of dam.
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.18 acres,
with a maximum depth of water of 6 feet; and approximate mean depth of water
4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$1500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before May 15, 1972

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1973
