

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, 97524, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Owen Reservoir.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unnamed Creeks, being 27.5 acre feet from West Unnamed Stream and 14.5 acre feet from East Unnamed Stream, tributary of Little Butte Creek, tributary of Rogue River.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 42.0 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation and recreation... recreation consisting of fishing, swimming and boating... see remarks.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 14

6. The dam will be located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 14,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 36 S., R. 1 E., W.M. The maximum height will be 31 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 375 feet; length on bottom 50 feet; width on top 15 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 3:5 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: earth fill - small reservoir, no wave protection provided.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Spillway located in saddle (State whether over or around the dam) - off channel.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 10" metal pipe line - 6" concrete encasement. (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 3.6 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 24.5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 11.6 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 6,500.00 (already built dam)...see Permit No. R-3519, this application being a refiling of Application No.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Owen Reservoir and the storage of water from West Unnamed Stream and East Unnamed Stream to be appropriated under application No. 49105, permit No. 36830, for recreation and irrigation being 27.5 af from West Unnamed Stream and 14.5 af from East Unnamed Stream, being 2.0 af for recreation and 40.0 af for irrigation

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 42.0 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is March 29, 1972

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 27, 1974 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1975...
