7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: wedge shaped pond 15' x 50' x 150'; 4' deep dug in native material.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: 8" x 10" wooden drain in south side of pond at natural ground level. (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: This dam is dug and picks up seepage water. (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 4,875 sq. ft. acres, with a maximum depth of water of 4 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1,500.

12. Construction work will begin on or before completed (1945).
