### Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, 97338, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Murray Reservoir #2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is intermittent drainage way

tributary of Little Luckiamute River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 8.1 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Stock  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 17  
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 8S, R. 6W, W.M., in the county of Polk

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 17  
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 8S, R. 6W, W.M. The maximum height will be 9.8 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 4.76 feet; length on bottom 78 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 7:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.8 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Constructed of Compacted Clay material

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 24" Trickle tube 12" conduit  
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1.8 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 1.2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 7.5 feet. see remarks

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2800<sup>00</sup>

12. Construction work will begin on or before 9-72

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 9-73
