2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Field drainageway tributary of SOAP Creek Luckiamute River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.5 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Stock water (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 31 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 9S, R. 5W, W.M., in the county of Polk

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 of The SE 1/4, Sec. 31 (Smallest legal subdivision) Tp. 9S, R. 5W, W.M. The maximum height will be 5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 340 feet; length on bottom 30 feet; width on top 16 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.
