Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Lake Safari No. 1 Cheetah Pond No. 2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is 2 Unnamed Draws tributary of South Umpqua River

3. The amount of water to be stored is #1- 1.75 #2- 0.70 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is #1 & #2 stockwater (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 17 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 28S, R. 6W., W.M., in the county of Douglas

6. The dam will be located in #1- NW 1/4 NE 1/4 #2- NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 17 (Smallest legal subdivision) Tp. 28S, R. 6W., W.M. The maximum height will be #1- 9 feet above stream bed or ground #2- 8.5 surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be #1- 7.5 #2- 8.5 feet; length on bottom #1 & 2 both 10 feet; width on top #1- 15 #2- 10 feet; slope on front or water side #1 3:1 #2 2:1; slope on back #1 3:1 #2 2:1; height of dam above water line when full #1- 3 #2- 2 1/2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Will be constructed of native clay soils. No need for wave protection. Will rip-rap for appearance.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: #1- 3' x 12' on natural ground around the dam. 2:1 on side slopes

#2- 3' x 2 1/2' x 45' long - on natural ground around the right side of dam

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: none - see remarks

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be #1-0.35 acres, #2-0.195 with a maximum depth of water of #1- 5 #2-9 feet; and approximate mean depth of water #1-5 #2-3.6 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2,000.


