Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Jacque E. Parsons (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, 97130 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Timothy Lake

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Rock Creek

tributary of Tualatin

3. The amount of water to be stored is 5 (See remarks) acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 4 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in SE of SW Quarter (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 4

Tp. 3S, R. 1W, W.M. The maximum height will be 8-9 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100' feet; length on

bottom 15 feet; width on top 15 feet; slope on front

or water side 3-1; slope on back 2-1; height of dam above water line (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

when full 2 1/2-3 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Constructed of parent clay soil (dam already constructed under permit No. R-1038). Dam height not to be increased.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Right bank,

2½' X 10' concrete - Over


9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 2' X 40' concrete culvert on flow line
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1.2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 8 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4-5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 3500 - 4000.

12. Construction work will begin on or before August 1, 1975

13. Construction work will be completed on or before August 31, 1975
