Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ernest A. Klopfenstein (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, 97381 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to construct the

following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is field drainage way tributary of Pudding River

6. The dam will be located in N 1/2 SW 1/4, Sec. 9 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 7S, R. 1W, W.M. The maximum height will be 29 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 110 feet; length on bottom 50 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 3 feet.
