Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, WALT DUYCK (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon 97113, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation N.A.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is N.A.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Filled by subsurface tile drainage system tributary of NA (Dairy Creek)

3. The amount of water to be stored is 3.01 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 20 Tp. 1N, R. 3W, W.M., in the county of Washington (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Not in running stream

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Drainage tile

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4, SE 1/4 and SE 1/4, SE 1/4, Sec. 20, sump Tp. 1N, R. 3W, W.M. The maximum height will be 0 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 121 feet; length on bottom 59 feet; width on top 105 feet; slope on front or water side 2:1; slope on back 0; height of dam above water line when full 0 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows:

The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 8" CMP located in NE corner (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 354 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 12 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 8.0 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1500

12. Construction work will begin on or before Aug. 1, 1975

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Oct. 31, 1975
