

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, J. A. Campbell (Name of Applicant)
of Route 2, Amity (Postoffice), County of Yamhill
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Campbell

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Salt Creek
tributary of South Yamhill River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 80 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. Diagonally along Salt Creek thru

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 NE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 15,
Tp. 6 S (No. N. or S.), R. 5 W (No. E. or W.), W. M. It will be 5 feet in height,

having a length on top of 30 feet; length on bottom 20 feet; width on top 6 feet slope of front or water side 2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) slope on back vertical (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 1/2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Concrete and earth already constructed -- has been in operation one year.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Thru center of dam. (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Water is pumped from reservoir. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

The right herein granted is limited to the storage of 80 acre-feet of water from Salt Creek, tributary of South Yamhill River for irrigation purposes, to be appropriated under Application No. 14329, Permit No. 10361. The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 80 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is September 22, 1931.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 27, 1932
