Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of OREGON, 97338, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

6. The dam will be located in N.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4, Sec. 4 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 7 S, R. 4 W, W.M. The maximum height will be 8 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 60 feet; length on bottom 12 feet; width on top 5 feet; slope on front or water side 2:1; slope on back 1.5:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

12. Construction work will begin on or before AUGUST 1976

13. Construction work will be completed on or before SEPTEMBER 1977
