

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Tillamook City Water Commission (Name of Applicant) of Tillamook City (Postoffice), County of Tillamook State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

Feb. 28, 1891

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Killam-Fawcett Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

Fawcett Creek tributary of Tillamook River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 200,000 gallons

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is domestic (municipal) (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 22 T. 2 S., R. 9 W.W.M. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions To be filled with 14" pipe

6. The dam will be located in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 22, Tp. 2 S, R. 9 W, W. M. It will be 9 ft. feet in height, diversion

having a length on top of 42 feet; length on bottom 42 feet;
 feet; width on top 1 1/2 feet slope of front or water side verticle
 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)
 slope on back 1/2 to 1; height of dam above water line when full
 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)
 0 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: The dam is to be built of concrete.

The above mentioned dam is the diversion dam from which the water is taken and carried to the reservoir. The reservoir being 43 ft. square on bottom and slopes 1 to 1 with 10 ft. verticle height.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: over dam.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: The outlet from the reservoir is an 18" pipe.
