following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is No. 1 & No. 2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is No. 1 Unn. Str. & Luckiamute R. and #2 Surface Runoff & Luckiamute R. tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is #1 - 7.2 & #2 - 6.0 \*SEE REMARKS acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 17 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 9S, R. 4W, W.M., in the county of POLK

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet #1 located at head of dry gulch and #2 located on relatively level ground

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions #1 is filled by runoff through the gulch, #2 is filled by runoff from the field and both are supplemented by pumping from the Luckiamute River

Tp. 9S, R. 4W, W.M. The maximum height will be 10 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be #1 - 140 #2 - 270 feet; length on bottom #1 - 40 #2 0 feet; width on top #1 - 40 #2 0 feet; slope on front

or water side 2 1/2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 2 1/2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Mostly EXCAVATION WITH PARTIAL EARTH EMBANKMENTS

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be #1-1.2 & #2-0.6 acres, with a maximum depth of water of #1-20 & #2-14 feet; and approximate mean depth of water #1-8 #2-10 feet.
