Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, CLIFFORD HERR (Name of Applicant)

State of ORE. 97381 (Zip Code), do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is UNNAMED

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is tributary of A SPRING PUDDING RIVER

3. The amount of water to be stored is 5.0 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is IRRIGATION (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 8 Tp. 7S, R. 1W, W.M., in the county of MARION (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet EXCAVATION NOT CONNECTED TO ANY STREAM CHANNEL

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions FILLED BY EXCAVATED SPRING

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 8, Tp. 7S, R. 1W, W.M. The maximum height will be 6 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 450' DIKE feet; length on bottom 425 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 6 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon 97310.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: COMPOSED OF SILTY CLAY & SILTY LOAM, DYKE SURROUNDING POND TO KEEP PUDDING RIVER OUT ~~BEFORE~~ DURING FLOOD SEASON

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: NO SPILLWAY (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 6" STEEL PIPE PLACED ABOUT 6' FROM TOP OF DYKE (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be .57 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 9 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 9 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ COMPLETED

12. Construction work will begin on or before 11

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 11
